Resolution approving the Preliminary Report excluding the traffic study and directing the architect to further study access to the proposed convention center hotel, Project M3-C003, MAPS 3 Convention Center, 500 South Robinson Avenue. Ward 7.

As a part of the MAPS 3 Program, The City of Oklahoma City will Background

construct a new Convention Center.

The Preliminary Report process began following approval of the site selection process. The architect met with the MAPS 3 Convention Center Subcommittee and City staff to receive comments and finalize the report.

The project meets all design requirements and is within the construction budget. The MAPS 3 Convention Center subcommittee requested the traffic study be excluded as more information is needed to address traffic flow along South Robinson Avenue. Additionally, the subcommittee requested the architect be directed to further study access to the proposed convention center hotel.

Upon approval of the report, the architect will be authorized to develop final plans and specifications, which will be completed in September.

The MAPS 3 Citizens Advisory Board recommended approval of the resolution on February 23, 2015 as revised by the MAPS 3 Convention Center subcommittee.
