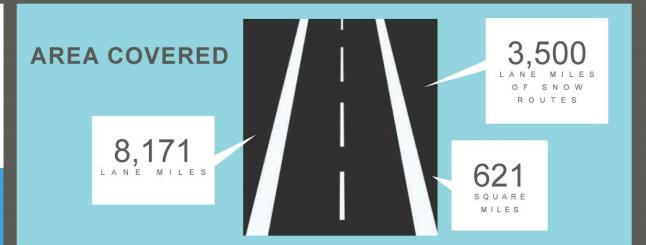

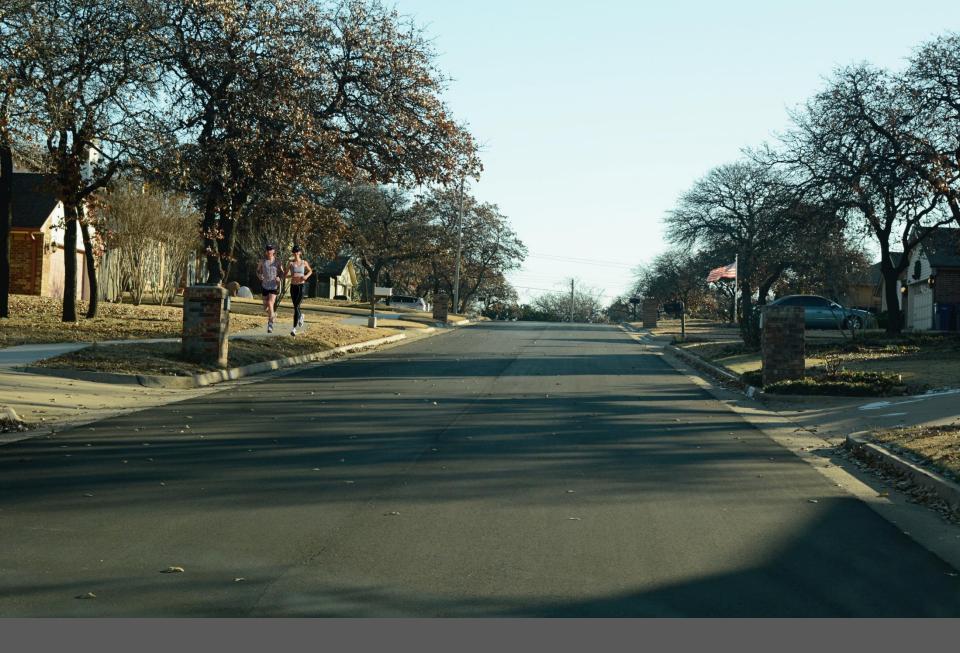

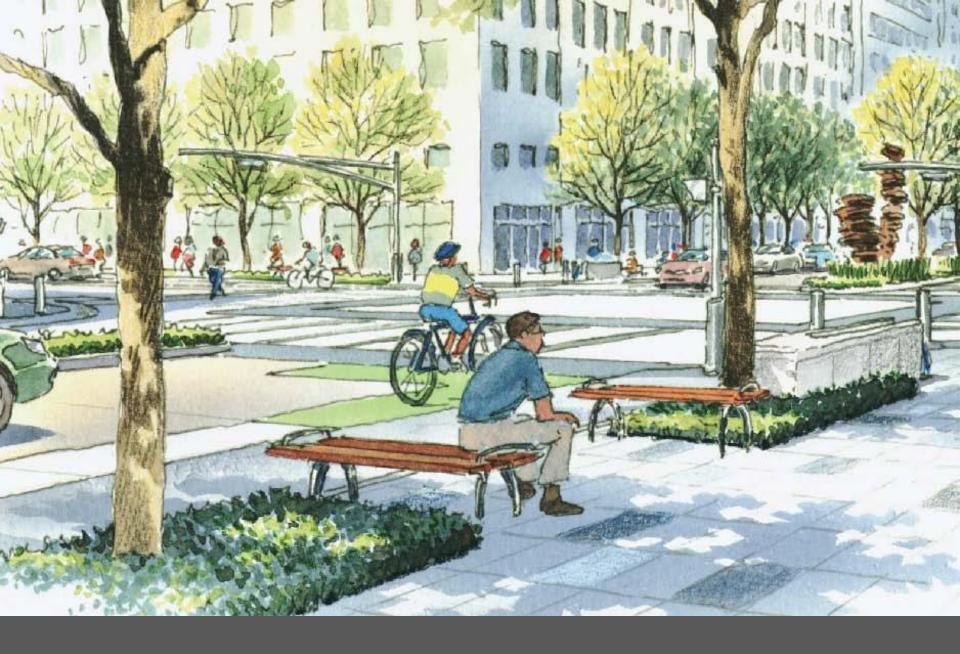

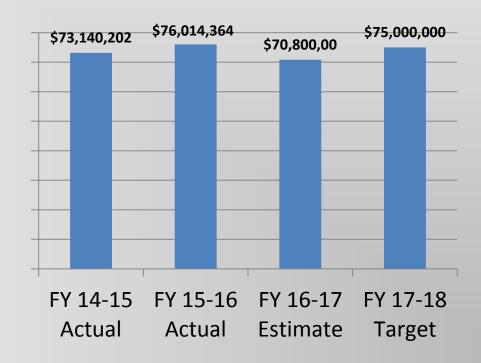

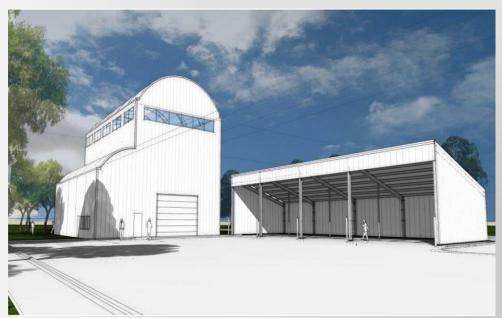

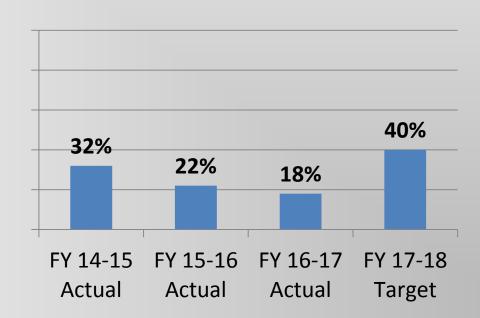

Condition of Arterial Streets



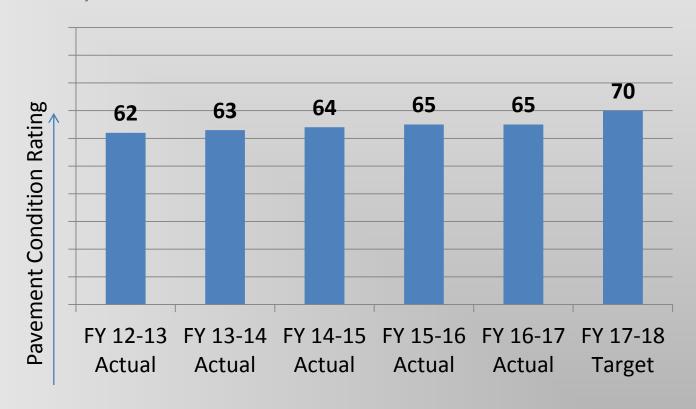

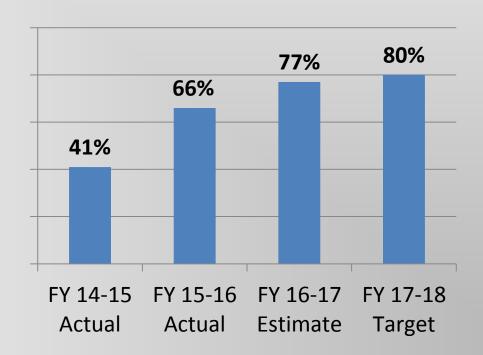

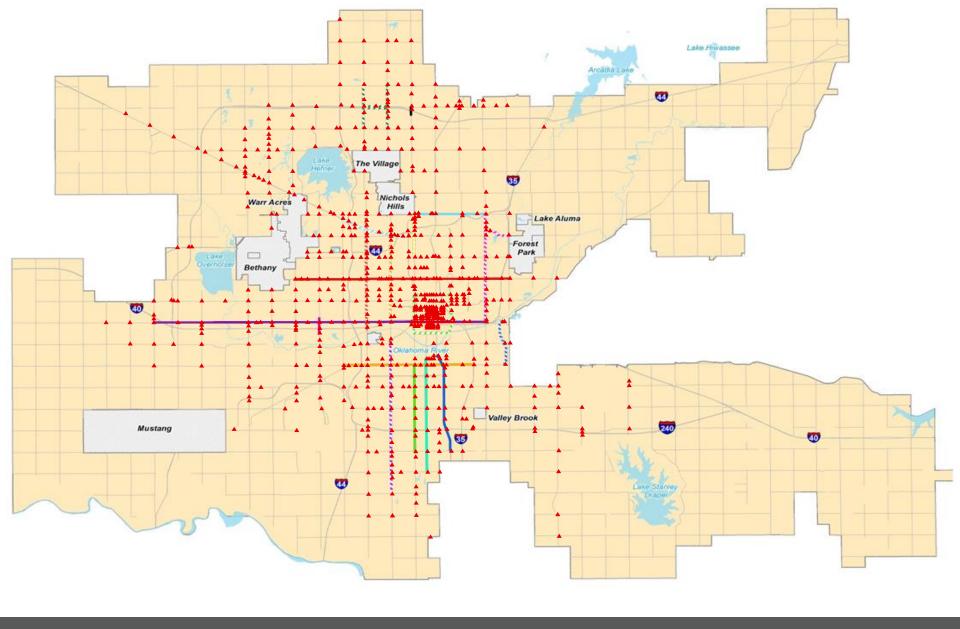














FY 2018 Outlook - Projected
