

City of Oklahoma City Permit Requirements for Fishing, Boating and Hunting

Fishing Permit

City permit required with State Fishing License for ages 16 to 62

Exemptions

- Any person under 16
- Any person 62 and older
- Any legally blind person and their assistant
- Any person with 60% or more disability with proof of extent and their assistant

Boating Permit

City permit required on ALL boats including canoes, kayaks, mini boats and inflatable watercrafts

State Registration also required for ALL watercraft except canoes and kayaks

Exemptions

- City permit not required for fisherman floats (tubes)
- No age exemptions on boating permit

Hunting Permit

City permit required with State and Federal licensing

Exemptions

- Any person under 16 when accompanied by an adult with valid City hunting permit
- City permit is for waterfowl, ducks, geese and dove hunting only

City Permit Costs

Daily Fishing	\$3.50	Daily Boating	\$6.25	Daily Hunting	\$3.00
Annual Fishing	\$18.50	Annual Boating	\$33.00	Annual Hunting	\$12.50

ALL daily permits good for 24 hours after purchase

ALL annual permits good for 1 year after purchase
