

EVENT ALCOHOL PERMITTING

Additional permitting is required to sell alcohol at your event. Your Special Event Permit does not allow you to sell any beer or alcohol at your event.

Event alcohol licensing procedure (including beer, wine, mixed drinks and liquor):

1 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) event license

Contact ABLE at least <u>60 days</u> before your event to determine what type of event license you will need. The <u>ABLE application</u> and additional information can be found at ok.gov/able.

NOTES

- Catering licenses cannot be used to sell at public events.
- Please include your alcohol vendor(s) on your <u>Special Events</u> <u>vendor list</u> and submit your list to the Oklahoma City County Health Dept. (specialevents@occhd.org) no later than 10 business days before your event.
- Fees apply for each license or permit.
- Call each agency before your visit to ensure you have all the needed documents to apply.
- You may need an OTC mixed beverage tax permit. Contact the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
